This April & May, Williamson Recycles / Keep Williamson Beautiful is bringing **Environmental Reading** to **kindergarten** classrooms! Keep Williamson Beautiful volunteers and community civic organizations partner to read environmentally-themed books to promote environmental and litter prevention awareness.

About the Environmental Reading Program:

- A Keep Williamson Beautiful volunteer will visit each kindergarten classroom at your school to read an environmentally-themed, age-appropriate story book and to spread litter prevention awareness to students.
- This **free program** is approximately **30-minutes-long**.
- Each class will receive a litter awareness pledge to sign and display in the classroom.
- Each student will receive an activity coloring book to take home!
- Each teacher will receive a reusable tote bag!

Environmental Reading content is correlated to the Tennessee State Standards and Williamson County Scope & Sequence for kindergarten. The program fits nicely into kindergarten curriculum and is timely with Earth Day, which is celebrated annually on April 22nd.

Environmental Reading will be available to Kindergarten classes in April & May of 2020.
